





THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OF PUERTO PRINCESA CITY: ADVANCING EDUCATION FOR EVERY LEARNER

The MIMAROPA Region comprises five provinces and seven Schools Division Offices, one of which is the Schools Division of Puerto Princesa City.

The Division Office is strategically located in the heart of the city, within the local government center in Barangay Sta. Monica, one of Puerto Princesa's densely populated urban barangays. It stands near the Puerto Princesa City Hall and other key government offices, ensuring accessibility and convenience for its stakeholders.

At present, the Division supervises 70 purely elementary schools, 26 secondary schools, and 5 integrated schools, totaling 101 public schools. In addition, the Palawan State University – Laboratory Elementary and Secondary Schools offer curricula from Grades 1 to 12, while 44 private schools provide education across various levels. The Division also oversees 44 Community Learning Centers (CLCs) under the Alternative Learning System (ALS) program. To ensure inclusive education, the Division has 21 school implementing Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd) Program, 3 schools offering Special Needs Education (SNEd) classes, and 19 schools conducting Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) classes.

All secondary schools implement various tracks of the Senior High School (SHS) program, ensuring that learners have diverse pathways for both academic and technical-vocational advancement.

Enrollment data over the past six years show a steady upward trend, largely driven by in-migration linked to the city's sustained economic growth. Currently, the Division has a total enrollment of 70,459 learners and is classified as a medium-sized Schools Division, with 2,662 teaching personnel and 350 non-teaching personnel - all dedicated to delivering quality, inclusive, and transformative education to the learners of Puerto Princesa City.

Guided by the Department of Education's mandate to establish and maintain a complete, adequate, and integrated system of basic education aligned with the nation's development goals, the Schools Division of Puerto Princesa City remains steadfast in its commitment to excellence, inclusivity, and equity.


